Subject: Award For Kindness

The organising Committee of the Pope John XXIII Award For Kindness is seeking the kind co-operation of all Heads of School and persons in charge of Institutions and Organisations in the selection of a boy or a girl who deserves the above Award.

This Award, apart from seeking to reward the winner, will also emphasize the innate kindness that one finds in the vast majority of children. The award is granted on the basis of love, kindness and generosity towards others.

The selected child will be receiving a gold medal bearing the image of Pope John XXIII from the President of Malta at an appropriate ceremony to be held at The Palace, Valletta.

Heads of School, institutions and Organisations are kindly requested to forward their nomination to the Hon Secretary, Pope John XXIII Award for Kindness Committee, Laboratorju tal-Paci, Hal Far ZRQ 06, by not later than Friday, 12th May 2006.

Details are to include:

1. The name and surname of the boy or girl who they think is eligible for this Award.
2. Date of Birth (nominated children should be between the ages of 8 and 14).
3. A photo of the child, if it is already available.
4. A detailed description of the child's good deed, love, kindness and generosity towards others. (Reference will be greatly appreciated).

Children nominated for this award must under no circumstances be informed that their case has been put forward for consideration. This would automatically disqualify them.

The Pope John Award for Kindness Committee is fully confident that there will be full co-operation on the part of all Heads of School and persons in charge of Institutions and organisations towards the success of this Award. It would also like to take this opportunity to thank them in anticipation.
