Heads of School are informed that the international charity ship Logos II will be berthed at Pinto Wharf, Valletta from the 1st to the 31st March 2007.

The Logos II is operated by Educational Book Exhibits Ltd. which is a non-profit charity organization and has an all volunteer crew and staff of 200 people from over 45 nations.

Since 1989 the Logos II visited more than 174 different ports in more than 29 countries and welcomed over 10 million visitors on board.

While in Malta, a variety of conferences and programmes for all age groups will be held on board the vessel while different teams will visit and work in different communities in Malta. The onboard bookshop will be opened to the public every day.

Heads of School are invited to send groups of students to the events being organized for schools. Students will have the possibility to go on board and enjoy the interactive and educational programme during which they will meet the international crew, share important Christian values for life and have an opportunity to visit the book fair.
