Scholarships for Postgraduate or Undergraduate studies in any discipline 2007/2008  
(for Maltese Citizens only)

The China Scholarship Council of the People's Republic of China is offering a scholarship to learn Chinese or engage in postgraduate and advanced studies in any discipline in Chinese Universities during academic year 2007/2008.

Students who do not know Chinese are required to take a course in elementary Chinese before taking up their speciality.

Applicants may choose three institutions and one speciality as personal preference. List of Chinese Institutions admitting International Students under Chinese Government Scholarship Programme is available on website: [www.csc.edu.cn](http://www.csc.edu.cn)

Travel expenses are not covered by the Scholarship.

Further information as well as application forms are available from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Valletta or the Information Section, Banca Giuratale, Victoria, Gozo. Application forms should be submitted to the Scholarships Section at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Valletta from 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m. and **by not later than noon of Monday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2007.**

Successful candidates may be required to enter into a contract to serve the Government or the Private Sector of Malta upon completion.

Applications from Government and Parastatal employees and from the Private Sector will not be considered unless recommended by their Head of Department/Employer respectively.

Late applications will not be considered.

The Board's decision will be final.
