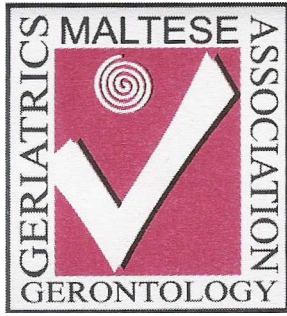

The committee is continuously striving to better the awareness on issues on older persons both nationally and internationally. One of this year's activities will include primary school children from State, Church and Private schools through a drawing competition.
