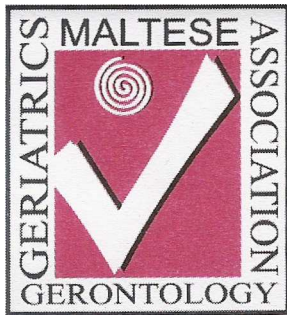

The Malta Association for Gerontology and Geriatrics (MAGG) is an academic organization based within the International Institute for Gerontology and Geriatrics at the University of Malta. Its members are all graduates of the said Institute and are all professionals working in the sociological and medical spheres pertaining to older people. The chairman of the MAGG is Prof. Joseph Troisi.

The committee is continuously striving to better the awareness on issues on older persons both nationally and internationally. One of this year's activities will include primary school children from State, Church and Private schools through a drawing competition. The theme for the drawing would, obviously, be about the old people in the children's lives. The theme titles are:

- 1) In-Nanniet
- 2) L-anzjan fit-triq tieghi.

The drawings should be of A4 size, either Portrait or Landscape

All participants are welcome and their drawings will be exhibited at St Vincent de Paul Residence.

The competition will be divided into two categories. Category A will include children in years 1, 2, 3 while Category B will include children in year 4, 5, 6. Each category will have three book token prizes, the first prizes tokens being of 70euros, the second of 47 euros and the third of 24 euros. Each school participating will be rewarded a certificate of participation from the MAGG.

The closing date for the submission of the drawings will be **March 28<sup>th</sup>** with the actual exhibition and competition being held 7<sup>th</sup> April to 12<sup>th</sup> April 2008. The pictures could be sent to:
